Are your construction clients vulnerable to industry fraud and corruption? Experts in construction compliance will discuss the major traps for the unwary and how construction clients can be protected. Topics include: "Pay to Play" (is it bribery, a kickback or extortion?); are the subcontractors who they say they are, and are they doing what they are supposed to be doing? (MWBE/CUF Fraud); insurance fraud (workers compensation and disability insurance payments; debarred lists); payment of appropriate labor rates (PW fraud/PLA fraud); security companies (guard-licensing requirements); employees' precarious legal status (fake OSHA cards); the False Claims Act, Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, U.S. Anti-Boycott Laws, and compliance with local-foreign laws.
